ACTIVITY GUIDELINES

Members are required to take photos under given subject areas within the competition time and hand over captured images at the end of the competition time. Date of the event is Sunday May 20th and the time will be 9.00 am until 12.00 noon. Members are required to take only two photos of each subject. Taking many photos and deleting unwanted photos is strictly prohibited. Photos are to be in jpg format with NO CAMERA RAW IMAGES. Do not take a photo of two items together, they must be in separate photos.

An independent judge will do the judging. The judge will not be provided with the names of the photographers. A winner will be selected for each subject category and the overall winner will be selected from these winners. The winning photos will be shown at a Club night on June 12.

As EDITING IS NOT ALLOWED and only the image capturing skills are tested, this is a competition for all – experienced as well as less-experienced photographers. Remember to put your camera onto single shot mode.

What to bring

- An empty memory card, a pen or pencil to write with.
- A cable or a card reader
- Sunscreen, hat and water
- You may take assistants with you, however, the ideas and photographs must be your own
- Wear your Club name badge if you have one

Commencing the photo shoot

- Be there before 9.00 am
- Collect topic and entry forms from Event Coordinator from 9.00 to 9.15
- Remember you need to take 2 photos for each topic – total number of photos should not exceed 20. THERE IS TO BE NO DELETION OF IMAGES.
- Whenever you take a photo, write down the number of the photo as appearing on the memory card under the relevant topic.
- Be creative. Go where ever you like within the park and keep it legal and safe. Maintain proper protocols and common sense, especially when taking photos including people. We don't want complaints from other park users,
- Upon completion hand in your memory card and completed entry forms for uploading between 12 noon and 1.00—pm. Please no later than 1.00 pm
